



Breaking Through The Wall

You're excited! You've worked hard to get this far and you feel good about what God has asked you to do – you are poised for such a good work! Moving full steam ahead pursuing your [Life Mission](#), you feel that this may actually happen. Then, in spite of all of your best efforts – **Bam! It's like you've run right into a brick wall.** Nothing seems to be working, challenges seem to come from nowhere. It's almost like God has removed his favor from you. "Why is this happening? "These trials will show that your faith is genuine. It is being tested as fire tests and purifies gold—though your faith is far more precious than mere gold." 1 Peter 1:7 (NLT)

Your faith is more valuable than gold to God; he loves purified faith.

Early in the Mission Curve™ process you made a move closer to God and set the stage to make a Spiritual S Jump (a change in belief). Your Intimacy with God was invigorated and you started along the path of your adventure. Here's the thing: Your new belief has not been tested. He wants to see that you are all in... *"And it is impossible to please God without faith." Hebrews 11:6*

How do you break through The Wall? David lays it out nicely in Psalm 37.

Trust in the Lord and do good.

Then you will live safely in the land and prosper.

⁴ *Take delight in the Lord,*

and he will give you your heart's desires.

⁵ *Commit everything you do to the Lord.*

Trust him, and he will help you.

⁶ *He will make your innocence radiate like the dawn,*

and the justice of your cause will shine like the noonday sun.

⁷ *Be still in the presence of the Lord,*

and wait patiently for him to act. Psalm 37:3-7 (NLT)

Trust, Delight, Commit, Be Still and Wait Patiently. This is not your little "life project" to help others. This is God's great work in you. Only by doing these things can the work continue.

Try it. Spend a day "Delighting in the Lord". (Don't confuse this with delighting in his creation.) I like to imagine me at his side, noticing everything, watching him at work. Brings a huge smile to my face! Do this once and you'll want to do it again the next day.
