

Doodling Your Job

Many moons ago, my 3rd grade teacher introduced me to “**Doodling**”. She would draw a squiggly line or partial shape on a plain sheet of paper. **My job was to transform that line into a complete image of something, making it become more than first appeared.** Talk about testing your imagination! I would look from all angles until a vision formed in my mind. Now I use doodling with kids all of the time when teaching them.
