



## **In Over Your Head**

***"When you go through deep waters,  
I will be with you.***

***When you go through rivers of difficulty,  
you will not drown." Isaiah 43:2 (NLT)***

I remember visiting my best friend's cottage on Lake Muskoka, Canada when I was a kid. Such a beautiful place! Fantastic fishing, granite points protruding into the water, islands. Their place was nestled on the side of a quiet inlet, perfect for swimming in the cool waters. Soon after arriving, having been in the car for 8 hours, we were anxious to take a dip.
