

Need a Mission Transfusion?

Sometimes being a Christian seems so complicated. Sermon after sermon, study after study... there is practical application for all parts of life. Good stuff, and needed! But is good coming at the cost of pursuing the core mission Jesus came to here to complete?

that the oppressed will be set free, and that the time of the Lord's favor has come." He rolled up the scroll, handed it back to the attendant, and sat down. All eyes in the synagogue looked at him intently. Then he began to speak to them. "The Scripture you've just heard has been fulfilled this very day!" ~Jesus Christ| Luke 4:18-20 (NLT)

Jesus spoke plainly about what he was sent here to do and remained focused with crystal clarity on this throughout his ministry. He was very deliberate...thankfully!

As he neared the dramatic end of his ministry on Earth, he had a number of candid conversations with his disciples, including an open prayer to the Father when he declared:

"Just as you sent me into the world, I am sending them into the world." ~Jesus Christ| John 17:18 (NLT)

Was he sending them out to help people improve their marriages, learn how to manage their money or parent better? No, he focused on the main thing, he was passing the baton of his ministry...not just to his disciples, but "also for all who will ever believe in me because of their testimony." (John 17:20) Jesus emphasized that our top priority must line up with his top priority.
